SPOTLIGHT - FOUNDATION YEAR

Students who successfully reach progression standard by the end of their Foundation Year will automatically gain entry to Year 1 of their registered degree course without the need for a further UCAS application.

As part of the programme, all students study the following **modules**:

- Concepts, Methods and Theories (CMT) - this module is tailored to the faculty or course the student progresses to
- Scholarship in Higher Education (SHE) - this module is designed to expose students to key academic skills
- Advanced Scholarships in Higher Education (ASHE) - this module allows students to complete a piece of academic research.

Science, Business, and Social Science students study Maths at the level appropriate to their chosen course. Modules may change in future years.
